Mt. Sanbe

Mt. Sanbe consists of six peaks with the main peak, Osanbe, having an elevation of 1,126m. There are five climbing courses available including a trail that winds through natural forests, a trail that passes through grassy fields with excellent views, and a route that takes you to the peaks in the fastest time via a chairlift.



Yanashio Road

Iwami Ginzan Roadway along with the mineshaft of Iwami Ginzan Silver Mine were registered as a World Heritage Site in 2007. A section of the 7 km is called Yanashiomichi.You can appreciate the history of the silver mining era, when silver was transferred from the silver mine to the port via a land route over 140 km long.



Mt. Kotobiki

This sacred mountain where Japanese gods come together.

The mountain is described in documents from over 1,300 years ago, has been worshiped by people for centuries. Even beginners can reach a peak in about 70 minutes.



Mt. Oyorogi

This mountain popular for its beechwood forest home to many plants.

At the top of Mt. Oyorogi, there is a primary forest of beech trees that are over 100 years old. The trail up the mountain has been carefully maintained to enable children and beginners to enjoy hiking.

The Shimane Nature Museum of Mt.Sanbe "Sahimel"

The museum features virtual exhibitions showing the dynamic birth of Mt. Sanbe and the existing natural surroundings. Visitors can enjoy displays of fossils and stuffed animals, visit the planetarium and astronomical observatory.



Oshimenawa Sosakukan

This place creates the largest shimenawa, a sacred rope (13.6 m wide weighing 5.2 t), for Izumo Taisha Grand Shrine. Workshop staff offer a craft class where visitors can make a small shimenawa using special

This Buried Forest Park is mysteriously preserved ancient forest that has many huge trees entombed in the earth as a result of a volcanic eruption that happened almost 4,000 years ago. You can observe closely that some trees remain standing in their original state.


Snowshoe Hiking
